- Advocacy Stand and Deliver Practicum Hot Topics, Facilitation Practicum Hot Topics, and Written Essay Theme Announced

MAY 1, 2017

- Email "What do you hope to accomplish as a national officer?" essay (1,000 words or less) and SAE program description per year (200 characters or less per year) Office of Agricultural Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.state.nj.us.

MAY 25, 2017

- Introduction of New Jersey's National Officer Candidate(s) at Convention Session IV (7:30pm)

JUNE 1, 2017

- Email completed National Officer Candidate Development Form to Office of Agricultural Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.state.nj.us. This form can be found on the State Activity Guide.

JUNE 10 OR 11, 2017

- Facilitate workshop at State Officer Leadership Training

JUNE 14, 2017 *(Tentative)*

- National Officer Candidate Selection Process
